### ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID

Sealed Bids will be received by the Association of Educational Purchasing Agencies (AEPA) on behalf of Cooperative Educational Services and its other AEPA Member Agencies until 1:30 p.m. EDT, Friday, October 14, 2011 for: A. Note that Bidders must be able to provide their proposed products and services in up to 24 states including California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Mexico, North Dakota, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Texas, Virginia, Washington, Wisconsin and Wyoming.
