This training highlights evidence-based speech and language strategies grounded in the Science of Reading to support preschoolers in special education and early childhood classrooms.

Teachers will learn to strengthen oral language, vocabulary, phonological awareness, and comprehension through explicit instruction, rich language modeling, interactive read-alouds, structured play, and intentional routines.

The training emphasizes data collection and progress monitoring to support strategies for decisions prior to referral for special education evaluations, while also reinforcing goals for students already receiving speech and language services.

By embedding SLP targets into daily classroom activities, teachers can collaborate effectively with speech-language pathologists and provide consistent, meaningful support within the data collection process for early childhood.
