As the end of the school year approaches, student self-determination takes precedence with exit IEPs and Summary of Performances. Research demonstrates that students with more involvement in their IEP meetings positively correlate to better postsecondary outcomes. This presentation will explore effective practices to promote student involvement, increase self-advocacy skills, graduation exit checklists, and effective ways to complete the Summary of Performance for students with disabilities.

This presentation will also reflect on the current postsecondary outcomes survey data for New Mexico to clarify the pursuits of students exiting high school.
