Evaluation Data Requirements

The team cannot make an eligibility decision based on a single test or a single person's opinion.

Legal Criteria for Eligibility

To legally qualify a student for services, the MET/EDT must establish **two things**

Protection Against "Predetermination"

By law, the team cannot decide whether the child qualifies *before* the meeting actually happens

Documentation and Forms

At the end of the meeting, the team must complete a formal **Eligibility Determination Form**.
