AM: Social Development, Deficits, and Differences

- Triad of Social Impairments: Communication, Imagination, and Relationships
- Educational Impact of Social Impairment
- The "Hidden Curriculum": Social information not directly taught BUT is assumed that everyone knows
- *Social Thinking Framework*: Practical strategies to help students process and respond to social information

PM: Classroom Social Skills Supports for All Ages

- Anchor Charts, Social Stories, Social Autopsies & other interventions to increase positive behaviors
- Building Community in the Classroom
- Social Interaction Teaching Plans
- Social Skills IEP Accommodations, Goals and Objectives
