We will examine a number of positive approaches to increasing prosocial behaviors in the classroom. The focus will be increasing self-regulation using cognitive behavior principles. Specific techniques will be discussed including modeling, self-talk, problem solving, skills training, a systems approach to increase positive behaviors and a model for school-wide implementation.
