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Alternative pathway to NM Level 3B Administrative Licensure

The PLD program is approved through the Professional Standards Commission as an alternative pathway to licensure for aspiring principals and others interested in the NM Level 3B Administrative License.

Those interested must have a Masters degree, with 3 years of teaching or related service experience, and a Level 2 or 3A Teaching License or a selected related service license. The applicant must have a Superintendent's or Charter School Leader's recommendation and a commitment to stay with their district for 3 years.

Year-long courses start in August and January.
