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Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports has been shown to be an effective component in having students reach their full potential. It shows the greatest positive effect with school-wide application. This training will examine strategies that can be implemented school-wide, in an individual classroom or for a struggling student. Strategies include:

-  Data collection for planning and assessment
-  Providing appropriate structure and predictability
-  The use of positive performance feedback
-  Meeting expectations through skill acquisition
-  Individual plans for a student need of assistance
